“Chinese Made Easy for Kids” Books 1 & 2 are recommended for beginners **Key Stage 1** (from age 4-7)

“Easy Step to Chinese” Book 1, 2... recommended for beginners at **Key Stage 2** (from age 7).

Use “Chinese Made Easy for Kids” Books 3 & 4 for **KS2** if learner has already studied Chinese in **KS1**

(If a substantial amount of ESC series has been studied at primary level the learner could start with CME series at secondary level for a faster pace)
